Old Business:

- ❖ organ – Linda contacted Mark Snyder at Music Solutions. He said we probably need new pedal cushions. They are 8 years old. Finance Committee and Council have approved \$714 (\$595 estimate, plus 20% for contingencies) to repair and maintain the pedals. Money will be taken from memorial funds designated for “Worship Enhancement”.
- ❖ butterflies in sanctuary – The butterflies were taken down Monday, April 16. Next year, we will plan on doing it on a Saturday because it works better for our “ladder” guys.
- ❖ Pentecost – We liked the idea of using red ribbons like leis; Bev volunteered to look for ribbon. Hopefully, most will remember to wear red on Pentecost. Geranium sign-up poster is up, asking for \$5. Sherry will make bread to use for communion. Liz suggested have a cake to celebrate the Church’s birthday.

New Business:

- ❖ setting changes – we are using setting 1 through Pentecost, then we will switch to 8 to use through the summer, because Sam is most familiar with that and is available more often to accompany on Sundays during the summer. We will switch to another setting (perhaps 6 or 7?) in the fall.
- ❖ summer concerts – Susie has scheduled and confirmed six summer concerts. They are as follows:

 - June 20: Two of Us (Doug Janicke and his niece – Doug was a member of Acoustic Juice; also a recommendation of Sam Fiorenza)

 - Aug. 8: Alleluia Quartet (Janette Erickson’s cousin is a member)
 - Aug. 22: Patte Armato Lund (member)
- ❖ Ewer – Pastor would like, at some point, to get a ewer (pitcher) from which to fill the font each week. He has not looked into them yet, however he will, and he invites others to research it as well. To avoid splashing, it was suggested that nice looking rocks or marbles be put on the bottom of the basin.
