Old Business:

- ❖ organ – Mark Snyder from Music Solutions replaced the pedal cushions for \$595. The bill is paid, however Lois Johnson's memorial funds were not sufficient to pay for it. Phil said they have not yet determined out of which other memorial fund it will be paid.
- ❖ Pentecost 5/20 – Sherry ordered 50 geraniums, the ribbons that Bev cut to go around people's necks were well received, and lots of members wore red. Bev mentioned something that they did at Valparaiso University on Pentecost (Baccalaureate) as something we may want to look into doing here, in the future. At Valpo, as the clergy, faculty, and students processed in, there was a person who carried in the cross, and right behind, there was another person carrying in a long pole, on which three long, red ribbons were attached. The person waved them over the congregants on each side as they walked up toward the front of the sanctuary.
[Another discussion began, regarding a processional cross.]
- ❖ setting changes – we started setting 8 on June 3 and will continue using it until Rally Day (Sept. 9(?))
After Rally Day, we will use either setting 6 or 7
- ❖ baptismal font ewer – the ewers that Sherry found that could fit under the font didn't have a large enough capacity. She will continue to look into it; Pastor will join the effort.

New Business:

- ❖ setting notes – June 24, we will use white paraments (rather than green), to celebrate John the Baptist.

- ❖ summer concerts – Bev is hosting June 6; Sherry is hosting June 20. There are enough cookies; more water bottles may be needed. Bev made a program for tomorrow night's concert, to hand out to the audience members, listing all the musicians, as well as a song list.
The circle drive will be blocked so people don't try to come in through those doors.
- ❖ outdoor service/picnic – The SVLC picnic has not yet been determined, as key (planning) people will not be here that 'typical' Sunday in August. Also, Pastor Dan Wynard from Alpine Lutheran mentioned to Pr. Scott the possibility of having a joint worship outside in a park sometime this summer. They will discuss
