OLD BUSINESS:

The repairman recommended buying a used organ that would work with our existing speakers. Richard did go to a piano store and checked into 2 options for buying a new instrument. The committee will look into this more at the next meeting. Richard also mentioned that the 2 pianos needed tuning and will be contacting Richard Dowling to get that done. Communion hymns were also discussed as to whether to continue with the current 1 verse hymn we were currently doing or going to other communion hymns we used in the past. We will continue as we are doing for now.

Another topic discussed was how to get people to make requests for hymns. It was decided to place a basket for requests at this time which Carolyn will do, then maybe do a hymn sing sometime in the summer.

Setting Changes: Richard mentioned settings 1,2 and 4 had not been used for some time. He suggested setting 4 which was approved unanimously. We have had positive comments on adding the guitar to the service and Sam is interested in learning a couple of more settings.
